



## **INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITY** **Engineering**

Internship opportunities are currently available with the Georgia Ports Authority (GPA) for the summer of 2007. GPA is seeking an undergraduate student with the desire to gain experience in the field of Engineering.

Job duties will include the following:

- Fire protection and other utility system mapping using GPS, valve identification, valve operation, fire hydrant flushing and system testing in the field at Georgia Ports Authority Garden City and Ocean Terminals in Savannah, GA.
- Generating as-built utility system drawings utilizing AutoCad or Microstation.
- Other duties as required.

Other requirements and qualifications:

- Have a basic knowledge of water systems and the proper use of test equipment/testing procedures required to locate, isolate and troubleshoot fire protection and water systems.
- Ability to interpret water system schematic and isometric drawings, and site layout drawings.
- Must be able to lift 30 lbs.
- Ability to work both independently and in a team.
- Completed courses:
  - AutoCad or Microstation (required)
  - Surveying (desired)
  - Fluid Mechanics (desired)
